Leadership Licensure Program/Graduate Certificate in School Leadership (LLP/GCSL)



Current conditions have demanded principals acquire new leadership skills that are flexible, inclusive, and transformative. Leaders influence systemic change by creating shared goals and promoting effective practice. With this graduate certificate, you can make a difference in school systems and in the lives of students, teachers, and other administrators.

Program Information

The LLP/GCSL program is jointly offered through the Massachusetts School Administrators' Association (MSAA) and William James College. Using concepts from psychology and adult social emotional competencies, the LLP/GCSL program will teach you to lead diverse and multicultural workforces and transform school cultures to be equitable, inclusive, and effective. LLP/GCSL is a yearlong, 18-credit, principal preparation program that is delivered in an online format. It is aligned to the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) administrator standards and designed to prepare you for the MA PAL state assessment for licensure.

Real World Learning

Field work is a transformational part of your educational experience. Through this program, you will engage in a 500-hour practicum, which is also required for licensure. If you are not currently working in a school setting, we will assist you in finding a placement.
