Coaches are required to read and adhere to the following:

- Sportsmanship Award nomination forms (<u>click here</u>) are due to the MSAA by November 14th. This award is open to all MSAA sanctioned schools. Please submit your team nomination today.
- REGISTRATION: Teams will <u>only</u> be allowed entrance at their <u>designated check-in time & in full uniform ready to compete</u>, teams arriving early will not be permitted entrance.
 - ROSTERED ATHLETES ONLY: all participants must be listed on the competing team roster (including
 alternates). Participants not listed on the roster submitted to the MSAA are ineligible for competition.
 Only bona fide team members are allowed to enter the competition free of charge. All other members
 (including junior varsity members) will be required to proceed to the spectator entrance and pay
 admission. (See MSSAA Rules & Regulations, Rule 13A.)
 - ONLY 3 COACHES will be allowed to enter with the team at no cost. All other coaches, choreographers, support staff, etc. will be required to proceed to the spectator entrance and pay admission.
 - PERSONAL BELONGINGS: All athletes are required to leave <u>all</u> personal belongings (warm-ups, backpacks, etc.) on the bus athletes will not be granted entrance into the school with any type of personal belongings. Coaches will be permitted to have a back-pack/the like. Please note we will permit appropriate Game Day Props.
- BUS PARKING: Buses should park in the upper lot farthest away from the school entrance
- No banners/posters/seat savers/etc. will be permitted
- GENERAL: Student-athletes, coaches, administrators, spectators, officials and all other persons connected directly or indirectly with a participating school shall adhere to the principles of good sportsmanship and the ethics of competition before, during and after the event. A violation of this rule may result in disciplinary action. (See MSSAA Rules & Regulations, Rule 34.)
- An Athletic Trainer is available in the gym for medical assistance. The trainer will not be available for precompetition tape please plan accordingly.
- Coaches & team be reminded that timing starts with the 1st choreographed motion/word. Routines are not permitted to exceed 2:30 for performance teams and 3:00 for game day teams. Lengthy choreographed entrances will be timed and teams exceeding the allotted time will be penalized.

It is imperative that coaches review and understand the Game Day Rules for the Game Day State Championship this Sunday, November 13, 2022.

At the state championship penalties <u>will be assessed</u> in accordance to the <u>MSAA Game Day Rules</u> and the NFHS Spirit Rules.

A few reminders on the Game Day Guidelines:

- Band Chant: Stunting and Tumbling are NOT allowed
- Situational Sideline: Stunting and Tumbling IS allowed
- Crowd Leading: Stunting and Tumbling IS allowed
- Other Rules:
 - o No Tosses
 - o No Inversions
 - o No Twisting Released Dismounts
 - o Single Leg stunts are limited to libs and hitches (no body positions)
 - No Running Tumbling
 - o Standing Tumbling limited to ONE tumbling skill with max difficulty of a back tuck
