 - a. Somerset- Some hybrid schools transitioning to 4 days with so many full remote students
 - i. Spikes not being seen coming out of schools (not a spreader)
 - b. Rowe- Full in person
 - c. Clinton- High Needs ½ day in person, others remote, trying to transition more students back
 - d. Reading- started full remote then hybrid but seeing some increase in cases
 - i. District wide survey (parents, staff, MS/HS students about teaching and learning)
 - ii. Full remote is synchronous (no asynchronous time)
 - e. East Hampton- full remote then K/1st into HS (ventilation), then special population and some HS students (learning center to attend remote), SC shut it all down- 100% remote now. Plan to bring some students back in January

 - b. Is deep cleaning needed if spread mostly respiratory
 - i. Not all schools take 'weds' off for deep cleaning
