Roster: Each team competing at the State Championship must submit an updated roster in a WORD or EXCEL format to blenote@miaa.net by **Monday, November 14 at 12:00 PM**. Participants not listed on the roster submitted to the MSAA are ineligible for competition. Only bona fide team members are allowed to enter the competition free of charge. All other members/coaches (including junior varsity members) will be required to proceed to the spectator entrance and pay admission.

Coaches: Each team will be provided with credentials for **up to 3 coaches**. Only competitors and coaches with the proper credentials will be allowed in the warm-up area.

Music: Teams will have music submitted for regional performances transferred to states. Any changes must be submitted to StateCheer1@gmail.com no later than Thursday, November 17.

Each team must bring a backup copy of their music to the music station for their team's performance. This person must stay with the DJ and be prepared to indicate when to start/stop the music.

Arrival: Buses should enter campus through the North Entrance across from the Chandler Magnet School. For more accurate GPS directions to the North Entrance, an address of **525 Chandler Street, Worcester** can be used. Parking will be in the Wellness Lot adjacent to the Wellness Center. Signs will mark the entrance to the "Bus Parking" and a parking attendant will direct buses to the unloading and parking area.

Athletes must arrive at registration dressed in full uniform ready to compete.

Schools needing taping for non-emergency situations should provide their own tape for the on-site trainer.

Registration: Teams should plan to arrive at their designated registration time.

Athletes are asked to leave all personal belongings (warm-ups, backpacks, etc.) on the bus. Space will NOT be provided to store belongings. Coaches will be permitted to have a team bag(s). **The MSAA and Worcester State University are not responsible for lost or stolen valuables.**

General: Stunting outside of the warm-up area is prohibited. No stunting on the grass, parking lot, or concrete outside of the facility.

Horns, noisemakers, confetti, and balloons are not permitted. Attaching items to the gym wall is strictly prohibited – **including team banners**.
